VIREO · Meghan Fernandes

Sizing and Measurements: 1 (2, 3)

To fit hand circumference: 17 (19, 21.5)cm / 6¾ (7½, 8½)”

Finished hand circumference: 11.5 (13, 15)cm / 4½ (5, 6)” – to be worn with 5-6.5cm / 2-2 ½” negative ease

Total Length: 32 (33, 34.5)cm / 12½ (13, 13½)”

Finished Length with cuff folded back: 24 (25.5, 26.5)cm / 9½ (10, 10½)”

Yarn: John Arbon Textiles Viola (DK weight; 100% Merino wool, ; 250m / 273 yds per 100g / 3.5oz skein)

Shade: English Mustard; 1 skein

Gauge: 20 sts & 32 rows = 10cm / 4” over 2x1 Twisted Rib pattern on smaller needles.

Needles: 3.75mm / US 5 knitting needles suitable for working small circumferences in the round.

4.5mm / US 7 knitting needle for cast-off

Always use a needle size that will result in the correct gauge after blocking.

Notions: 3 stitch markers, scrap yarn, cable needle, tapestry needle.

Notes: Vireo are worked in the round from the wrist upwards.

Stitch Glossary

2x1 Twisted Rib: [P2, k1tbl] to end.

2x1 Reverse Twisted Rib: [K2, p1tbl] to end.

C6F: Slip 3 sts to cable needle and hold in front, k3, k3 from cable needle.

C6B: Slip 3 sts to cable needle and hold in back, k3, k3 from cable needle.

Abbreviations

beg Beginning

cast off Bind off

inc Increase

k Knit

M1Lp Make 1 Left Purlwise; pick up strand between the two needles from front to back with the tip of the left needle, purl into the back of this stitch

M1Rp Make 1 Right Purlwise; pick up strand between the two needles from back to front with the tip of the left needle, purl into the front of this stitch

PM Place marker

p Purl

SM Slip marker

st(s) Stitch(es)

tbl Through the back loop



VIREO CABLE WRITTEN INSTRUCTIONS

Round 1: P2, k13, [p2, k1tbl] to end.

Round 2: P2, k13, [p2, k1tbl] to end.

Round 3: P2, C6F, k1, C6B, [p2, k1tbl] to end.

Round 4: As Round 1.

Rep Rounds 1-4 for pattern.

PATTERN BEGINS

Using smaller needles and the long-tail method, cast on 33 (36, 42) sts.

Join for working in the round, being careful not to twist. PM to indicate beginning of round.

RIGHT MITT ONLY

Working from the Chart or Written Instructions, work Rounds 1-4 of Vireo Cable pattern 9 times.

RIGHT MITT THUMB GUSSET

Round 1: Pattern 18 (19, 21) sts as set, PM, M1Lp, PM, pattern as set to end. *1 st inc*


Round 2: Pattern as set to marker, SM, p to next marker, SM, pattern as set to end.

Round 3: As Round 2.

Round 4: Pattern as set to marker, SM, M1Lp, p to next marker, M1Rp, SM, pattern as set to end. *2 sts inc*

Repeat Rounds 2-4 a further 5 (6, 7) times. *13 (15, 17) sts between markers; 46 (51, 59) sts total*

Next Round: Pattern as set to marker, remove marker, slip next 13 (15, 17) sts to scrap yarn, remove marker, pattern as set to end. *33 (36, 42) sts*



LEFT MITT ONLY

Working from the Chart or Written Instructions, work Rounds 1-4 of Vireo Cable pattern 8 times, then work Rounds 1-3 only once more.

LEFT MITT THUMB GUSSET

Round 1: Pattern as set to last 3 (4, 6) sts, PM, M1Lp, PM, pattern as set to end. *1 st inc*

Round 2: Pattern as set to marker, SM, p to next marker, SM, pattern as set to end.

Round 3: As Round 2.

Round 4: Pattern as set to marker, SM, M1Lp, p to next marker, M1Rp, SM, pattern as set to end. *2 sts inc*

Repeat Rounds 2-4 a further 5 (6, 7) times. *13 (15, 17) sts between markers; 46 (51, 59) sts total*

Next Round: Pattern as set to marker, remove marker, slip next 15 sts to scrap yarn, remove marker, pattern as set to end. *33 (36, 42) sts*

BOTH MITTS AGAIN

Work straight in pattern as set until the Vireo Cable pattern has been worked a total of 16 (17, 18) times from cast-on.

TOP CUFF

Work 2x1 Reverse Twisted Rib for 11.5cm / 4½". Using larger needle, cast off loosely in pattern.

THUMB


Slip 13 (15, 17) held sts on to smaller needle. Rejoin yarn, pick up and purl 1 (1, 2) sts in space just before first st, p13 (15, 17) sts, pick up and purl 1 (2, 2) sts in space after last st. Join to work in the round and PM to indicate beginning of round. *15 (18, 21) sts*
Purl 6 rounds.

Work 2x1 Twisted Rib for 5 rounds.

Using larger needle, cast off loosely in pattern.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and block to measurements.



Rep 6 (7, 9) times
